daytona, florida

Make a pit stop in this beach town on February 17 to catch the 50th Daytona 500, Nascar's version of the Super Bowl. —EVETTE RIOS

**DRIVE**

At the **Daytona 500 Experience** (1801 W. International Speedway Blvd., 386-947-6530; \$24 admission), next to the Daytona International Speedway, you can drive 200 mph—and endure a 360-degree flip—in a full-motion simulator. Or pick up an air gun and try to beat the clock at the pit-crew challenge.

**SLOW DOWN**

Relax after the big race at **The Shores Resort & Spa** (2637 S. Atlantic Ave., Daytona Beach Shores, 386-767-7350)—and get your fill of pampering with one of the food-themed treatments, like a Key Lime Margarita Manicure (\$60), Chocolate Raspberry Massage (\$105 for 50 minutes) or Peppermint Pedicure (\$75).

**EAT**

Racing's North Turn oceanfront restaurant (4511 S. Atlantic Ave., Ponce Inlet, 386-322-3258), a few miles down the shore from the speedway, stands on the strip of sand where stock cars originally raced. Fans flock here for the huge bar menu—and the likelihood of seeing a Nascar star or two.



CLOROX

Cleaning is a necessary evil, but breathing in all those harmful chemicals doesn't have to be. Clorox makes its new **GREEN WORKS** line of cleaners from biodegradable ingredients like coconuts and lemon oil. You won't have trouble finding them: They're rolling out now to mass retailers—and they're affordable, too (\$3 to \$3.40).

what a **sweet** guy

Boys deserve chocolate on Valentine's Day, too, but a heart-shaped box of bonbons won't cut it. —AMY THOMAS

It sounds kinky, but **RUB WITH LOVE COCOA NIB BARBECUE SAUCE** (\$6 for 16 ounces, tomdouglas.com) is indeed meant for cooking, and it's as tasty as Mexican mole.

Skip the standard breakfast in bed and serve him **VOSGES HAUT CHOCOLAT MO'S BACON BAR** (\$7, vosgeschocolate.com). Be warned: The odd combo of bacon, chocolate and smoked salt is meant for serious pork fans.

Pick up a pack of **DIVA CHOCOLATES MOCHA JAVA BEEF JERKY** (\$6 for 2 ounces, diva-chocolates.com) to show him why cocoa powder and beef were meant to be together—just like you two.

TABASCO SPICY CHOCOLATE's fire-red tins (\$13 for 3, countrystore.tabasco.com) are the first clue that this isn't a mellow box of sweets. The chocolate inside—made with hot pepper sauce—will set his heart racing.

Upgrade your sports lover's snacks with **DALE AND THOMAS' NEW CHEF CRAFTED POPFECTION BOX** (\$50, daleandthomas.com)—it's like a chocolate-covered ode to Cracker Jack, including popcorn truffles and more.
